- Letters of recommendation from school administrators or other community leaders.
- In good standing at her school and verified by their school counselor.
- Willing to make the time commitment necessary to gain a meaningful experience as a Spark Teen Board member.
- Willing to actively participate in meetings and activities.
- Able to provide her own transportation to meetings and activities.
- Participation in the Spark Teen Board program is limited to one time only, and applicants cannot reapply once they have completed the program.
